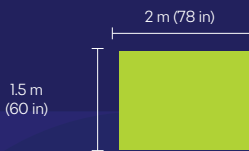


FLAGS, BANNERS AND POSTERS POLICY

CAN I BRING A FLAG, BANNER, OR POSTER TO THE STADIUM?

Small flags, banners and posters – not exceeding 2 metres x 1.5 metres (78 inches x 60 inches) – are permitted.



If a flag, banner or poster exceeds these dimensions, it must be approved in advance by FIFA.

HOW CAN I REQUEST APPROVAL FOR AN OVERSIZED BANNER, FLAG OR POSTER?

Requests can be made on the FIFA Fan Materials Portal and must be placed at least two days before kick-off.

ARE THERE ANY IN-STADIUM POLICIES OR RESTRICTIONS?

Hanging / Fixing of Flags and Banners

Where possible, designated locations for hanging banners will be available. These areas are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Due to the large number of spectators expected at FIFA World Cup 2026 matches, most fans will be required to hold their flags or banners rather than hang them. Safety and security staff will provide direction on matchday.

Fans must not place banners:

- where they block the view of other spectators;
- over commercial branding or LED boards;
- over safety or information signage;
- across the entire main stand;
- at pitch level opposite the main stand (main camera view).

Safety and security staff will enforce these requirements on matchday.

Prohibited Fixing Items

The following items are prohibited for securing or installing banners and will be rejected at stadium entry:

- long ropes
- cables
- duct tape
- tools or installation equipment

These items are not permitted inside the stadium.

WHAT SHOULD I DO WHEN I GET TO THE STADIUM?

All flags, banners and posters must be inspected at the stadium entrance.

Fans should arrive as early as possible to have their items inspected by the security personnel at the entry gates. We recommend arriving no later than two hours before kick-off, which is mandatory for fans with oversized items.

Banners, flags, or posters that exceed the size limits or differ from the approved submission will not be allowed.

WHAT KIND OF FLAGS, BANNERS AND POSTERS ARE PROHIBITED?

Items of a political, offensive, sexual, discriminatory or commercial nature are strictly prohibited and may result in expulsion from the stadium.

ARE ACCESSORIES SUCH AS FLAGPOLES AND POM-POM SHAKERS WITH HANDLES ALLOWED?

Flagpoles, banner poles and pom-pom shakers with handles are not allowed, except for flexible or double poles made of non-flammable plastic that are no longer than 1 metre (39 inches), no thicker than 1 centimetre (0.39 inches) and deemed safe by safety and security officials at the stadium.
